Satyakam has his roots in Asia and Europe, in the same way he plays music in an Eastern genre on a Western instrument. With this mindset of diversity Satyakam's wish is to bring art disciplines and communities together.

- In India he started his musical training under the guidance of Satyaprakash Mohanti in 1995.
- After migrating to the Netherlands he became a student of Ms Lenneke van Staaen, herself a Dutch virtuoso student of the renowned Indian violinist Pandit D. K. Datar.
- In 2006 Satyakam pursued his formal musical training enrolling in Codarts, the former Rotterdam Music Academy. He studied Indian violin under the guidance and supervision of the legendary Pt. Hariprasad Chaurasia and Pt. Dhruva Ghosh. As Satyakam combined his studies in the Netherlands and India he also received training from Dr. N. Rajam until 2011.
- In 2010 Satyakam obtained his BA from Codarts and his Masters in 2012.
- From 2016 Satyakam was awarded with the ICCR scholarship. Continued learning from Drubha Ghosh & Biswajit Roy Chowdhury until present.
